  - (3) Social and recreational activities
  - (4) Assistance with performing ADL's and IADL's
  - (5) Assistance with self-administration of medication or medication administration as indicated in the resident's assessment and support plan
  - (6) Household services
  - (7) Transportation

This fee schedule and bundling of Core Service is open for interpretation as written. The question remains as to whether the fee schedule for services and accompanying charges for the services to the resident will be permitted. It does not address if the residence has the option to bundle or unbundle specific core services.
