While we support the idea of improved safety and care measures for all persons no matter where they live, we do have some concerns about the following items:

- The proposed license fee structure is too high
- The administrator requirements are confusing
- Proposed room sizes prohibit Messiah Village from applying for a license
- Installing kitchens/microwaves/refrigerators are also prohibitive
- Allowing contracts to be rescinded after thirty days is burdensome
- Lack of 30-day notice to move out
- Restrictive transportation rules

We look forward to the implementation of the new regulations and trust that you will take the proposed intent and make it more practical from a provider's standpoint. We fully support PANPHA's proposed revisions and, as such, did not want to repeat the detail that you will find in their work.
