As such, I would like to share with you that should the proposed Assisted Living Regulations be adopted as is, it is highly unlikely that Simpson House would consider having a licensed Assisted Living as part of it's retirement community.

Simpson House is in favor however, of the changes to the proposed regulations as outlined in the attachment from PANPHA. With those changes, Simpson House and other communities serving seniors in the Commonwealth would be more likely to consider applying for an Assisted Living License. The proposed regulations would not improve the quality of care or quality of life of residents, but would impose higher monetary costs for both the seniors and the provider.
