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INDEPENDENT REGULATORY REVIEW COMMISSION

As a dental hygienist, who has recently completed a Bachelor's degree program in dental hygiene that included extensive coursework on special needs populations, I am writing to express my support for the regulatory changes that will impact the practice of dental hygiene in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

The elderly and special needs populations in Pennsylvania are two of the most vulnerable to the ravages of untreated disease of the supporting structures surrounding the teeth. These changes to the Practice Act will help make significant improvements in the ability to access preventive dental care for the elderly and those with physical and/or mental challenges.
