State Board,

Good evening, I am a registered professional engineer in the Commonwealth of PA. I have concerns that delays in enacting the proposed continuing education rule-making for engineers and land surveyors will cause some trouble for professionals' attempts to comply with the proposed rule-making in the upcoming renewal cycle. Can the board please provide any updates on the acceptance of the continuing education requirements from the proposed rule-making made May 2, 2009? The biennial renewal cycle has already begun (Sept '09) and so far the engineers practicing within the Commonwealth have not been officially notified whether or not they will be required to meet these requirements in the current cycle. Even though the proposed rule-making and the board's recent newsletters have indicated that the requirements for CE may have already begun. I have copied my state legislators so that they are aware of how this delay is affecting their representative body. I ask that the board and the assembly members act swiftly if these rules are to be imposed in this renewal cycle.
