

I am writing at this time to respectfully request that you reject proposed regulation #2777 Department of Agriculture 2-160: Milk Sanitation. I am concerned that some of the provisions in these new regulations are onerous and unnecessary and place an undue burden on the dairy farmers themselves.

For example, whether my milk bottle is capped by hand or capped by a bottling machine does not directly impact the quality or the safety of the milk I am receiving; whether the empty milk bottles are washed in one room or another, again, is mere semantics, and does not impact the quality or safety of the product that the farmer is striving to provide for his customers.
