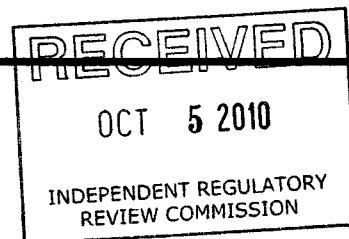

I am writing to express my strong hope that you DISAPPROVE proposed regulation #2777, Department of Agriculture 2-160.

As a regular consumer of a variety of raw dairy products, I am opposed to any changes that would create additional financial and logistical hardships for the farmers who are providing these wonderful products. It is clear to me that the proposed changes are more an effort to discourage this market than it is a matter of protecting public health. I consider the raw dairy products I consume much safer, given the way that the cows are cared for and the milk processed, than commercial pasteurized dairy products, with the disturbing reports of herd illnesses and milk contamination.

Please allow those of us who choose to consume delicious and healthful raw dairy products the right to choose.

Please do NOT alter the current regulations concerning raw milk production in Pennsylvania.
