The proposed regulation would impose severe as well as unnecessary financial and operational burden on farmers who are already struggling to maintain their businesses afloat. Furthermore, I do not believe this regulation will protect consumers, and rather, attention should be turned to the large agricultural operations that continue to send contaminated products into the public. Instead, with raw milk and other products from small farms, it would make better sense to me if the focus was on the final product's quality rather than the actual procedure to get it there.
