To Whom it May Concern:

This is a copy of a letter I have sent to Paul Hoge, Pennsylvania Department of Agriculture.

Please consider the following for your proposed milk regulations.

Direct producer-to-consumer transactions should be exempt from new regulation. These transactions are a help to the economy of Pennsylvania. I am sending over \$40 per week into Pennsylvania, and there are probably thousands of others doing likewise. This helps the Amish and other Pennsylvania farmers.
