## Comments

- 1. 102.4(b) (5) More clarity is needed to determine if every project requires a separate plan and Narrative. The District feels that small, simple projects can place all necessary information on plan drawings.
- 2. 102.4 (b)(8) Can Districts charge a review fee for this scenario?
- 3. 102.6 Permit application and Fees.

The District feels a tiered approach to fees for General and Individual NPDES applications. Example 1-5 acres and greater than 5 acres.

PBR should keep as is.

- 4. 102.6 (c) (2) Provide more clarity on review time. Is it 60 days for each resubmission. How many times can it be reviewed?
- 5. 102.15 Permit by Rule (PBR)
  - (b) Exclusions
  - (ii) A. Sinkhole development. More clarity is needed here. What is acceptable procedures and evaluations. Also the criteria to be used should be defined.
  - (iii) (4) needs more clarity As written it is open to opinion.
  - (c) Permit conditions-

Pre-submission meeting.

The District feels that a preliminary E & S and PCSWM should be brought to the meeting.

- 6. 102.22 Site stabilization
  - (b) (2) Temporary Stabilization.

The District feels that 3 days is excessive for stabilization measures. 7-14 days would be more reasonable.
