I would like to voice concerns about the Canine Health Board Regulations.

The fact that radiant floor heat cannot be the primary source of heat is a step backwards. Radiant floor heat is the best, cleanest, and safest heat man has invented. Radiant floor heat should be the only form of heat need in a kennel.

The change in whelping area flooring is not within the Canine Health Board's power according to Act 119.

The requirements for humidity contradict themselves. The range is 30° to 70° but if the temperature goes above 90° it is 12° which dangers to human health.

The recording devices the Department will install in my kennel violate my privacy rights.

I would like a chance to testify on radiant floor heat at the hearing.
