Canine Health Board Standards for Commercial Kennels

To Whom It May Concern:

After reading Pennsylvania Bulletin, Vol. 39, No. 37, September 12, 2009, I have several questions concerning the Proposed Rulemaking.

It is not clear in this document who will make the inspections of these Class C kennels. How will that person be trained in taking the required measurements? By whom? How will the law know about the offending kennels? May a private citizen report a kennel suspected of not complying with the law?

Paragraph 28a.3. Lighting (iii) - "Dogs shall be protected from excessive light." How is that defined? How long must a dog be exposed in order for it to be deemed vulnerable to "excessive light"?

May I suggest that some of the monies for enforcement of these new rules be used from fines imposed on offending "breeders". May I also suggest these rules be used for all kennels, not just Class C.

I am very delighted rules are being set up with the intention of eliminating some of the abject cruelty imposed on poor defenseless dogs by these despicable kennel owners.
