- 1. The Committee requests an explanation as to how to reconcile the conflict between the need of a veterinarian to obtain oral consent or a signature of an owner to perform humane euthanasia for an animal and the lack of need for client consent for euthanasia when a client cannot be contacted.
- 2. The Committee inquires as to how standards that veterinarians are to follow are determined to be "acceptable and prevailing".
