**Subject:** New Regulations on Wood-Fired Outside Boilers

As a enviornmentaly conscious homeowner, I am opposed to the proposed regulation of the outside boilers. In my situation, I spoke with the township codes officer and got the "go ahead" for the installation of a Hawken system. This will save approximatly 450 gallons of heating oil. With other energy saving methods, my electric bill has been cut in half and gasoline usage has been reduced due to replacing 8 cylinder cars with 4 cylinder models.

My lot is almost an acre and a half and the neighbors have been polled for any problems. There have been none. The boiler only emits noticable smoke during the first five minutes of blower useage.

I am appaled that the state is trying to intervene in an energy saving program on my property. If any regulation should be instituted, it should come from the local municipality since they are familiar with there own needs.
