I have been contacted by Senator Rafferty and have reviewed your proposals for EXISTING Outside Wood Furnaces. I have installed a Hawken outside wood boiler on my 1.33 acre property. In planning for its use, I took into consideration prevailing wind flow during the winter months when it will be used. Also proximity of neighboring dwellings. My property is open and the smoke is only visible at the chimney height, which is about 8 feet, during the first couple minutes of the blower usage. Once the fire is burning, very little if any smoke is seen. I have done everything possible to make sure my usage doesn't bother anyone. The proposed existing regulations will affect my stove since it is between 100 and 125 feet from the closest residence to the south west.
