INDEPENDENT REGULATORY

I think it is critically important to include in the proposed regulation of wood-fired boilers that the clean wood required (among other fuels) to meet the standards is "seasoned" wood. This alone would eliminate much of the smoking/particulate problem, especially in close residential areas.

I do have reservations, however, that the proposed required clearances from property lines and the height of stacks are totally impractical for all but the most isolated rural homeowners.
