25 PA.Code CHS. 121 and 123
Outdoor Wood-Fired Boilers
39 Pa.B.6068

We live on the edge of a small town in central PA. This is the 12th winter we have used our stove, I only burn seasoned wood and have never had a complaint from a neighbor.

The summer of 2008 our town passed a resolution the same as you requiring a person with an outside wood burner to receive a permit from the town council. We received a permit with out any problems at all. The reason the town required the permit was to control an outside furnace that was installed in the middle of town and they burned garbage and many other items continuing right through the summer causing complaints from the neighbors.

I do understand your concerns but I feel as though it would be better to allow each community to use their judgement to use your regulation to control any problems they find.
