My daily life experience with an OWB next to me since November 2008 tells me:

ALL NEW REGULATIONS must be enforced for ALL UNITS PAST, PRESENT AND FUTURE.

NO GRANDFATHERING. By grandfathering you are creating a second class of sufferers that will become ill and suffer severe economic hardship because the OWB was installed a year ago.

150 FOOT SETBACK IS NOT SUFFICIENT. Think along the lines of 500 feet.

STACK HEIGHTS need to be higher than occupied units 600 FEET from OWB, installed in the PAST AND PRESENT.

RELIEF PERIOD OF NO OPERATION during the six warmer months from April 15 to October 15.

All members are cordially invited to my 3 acre property that has been ruined by the placement of an OWB 35 feet from my property line.

The rancid stomach turning smell and mist covers the three acres and cocoons my house.

I can not use the yard, or have children play without burning noses, throats and lungs.

I have spent over three thousand dollars on room air purifiers for the house to control the smell that oozes in.
