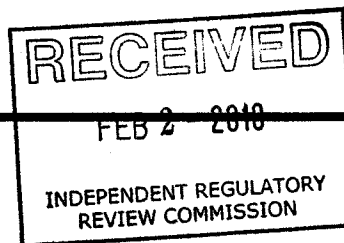

The cost would be unafordable for us as I am retired on somewhat of a fixed income.

The safety risk would high due to winds and creosote build-up in a 35 foot lenght.

As far as the trash that is burned in yhe furnance,we do not burn tires,plastics,chemicals,or the like.Are you suggesting that we we use a burn barrel or just burn it on the ground as many other rural residents and risk setting the mountaain on fire.

Our outdoor furnance does not pulute any more than most peoples indoor oil furnance or their fireplaces or woodstoves. We use almost all hardwoods emiiting a very small amount of smoke. We live on thirty acres of mountain land and our closet neighbour is almost a mile away.

When we had this furnance installed over ten years ago we were told that this was a safe and efficent way to go NO FLUE FIRES**NO INDOOR FUMES

So PLEASE, DO NOT allow these unfair regulations to be enated.
