INDEPENDENT REGULATORY REVIEW COMMISSION

I would like to let you know that I am very much in favor of state regulations on wood fired outdoor furnaces. We live in a rural area of PA and have a neighbor approximately 300 feet across the street from our home. He placed a furnace near the property line without any extension on the stovepipe. He operates it year round since it also heats his hot water so we have to put up with the smell year round. We cannot open our windows because the stovepipe bellows smoke and most times it blows our way. When his furnace fires up the smoke that comes out of the stovepipe is unbelievable and when it is cloudy or foggy the smoke really hangs low.

My husband has COPD and is on oxygen 24/7. The only enjoyment he had was sitting in our three season sunroom and enjoying the fresh air but that has ended now since he can't tolerate the smoke.

Requiring an extension on the smoke pipe to place it at least 2 feet above our 2 story house would be a marvelous relief for us.

Thank you for what you can do to regulate these existing furnaces would be greatly appreciated.
