Comments:

New DEP proposed REG on Outdoor furnaces 1. Set back distances from property lines are unrealistic. Set back distances should be from dwellings. The distance should be 75 feet from a neighbors dwelling,

distance from an owners dwelling should be up to the owner. 2 New regulations should not place new restrictions on existing furnaces. 3. Chimney height should be up to the owner and manufacturer unless the smoke interferes with a dwelling within 100 ft then it should be 2 ft higher than that dwelling's roof. 4. The only restriction on what you can burn should be recommended by the manufacturer and should include coal. The only restriction should be on garbage or other hazardous material.
