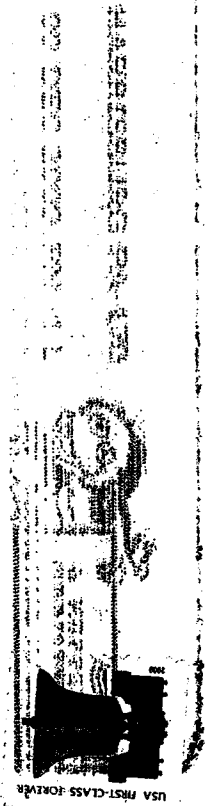
But now times are tough and I'm doing the best I can. I pray you back off your regulations and adhere to a common sense approach.
