I attended a talk and film on Monday December 7, 2009 at the Lansdale Public Library. Dr. Sandra Folzer spoke about the Natural Gas drilling that is beginning in PA and has been taking place across the country. The film described what has happened all across Colorado and the affects the gas drilling has had on people and nature.
