Chapter 95 regulations

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INDEPENDENT REGULATORY

Dear DEP Environmental Quality Board,

I am writing to comment on the proposed new Chapter 95 regulations. I support the three major effluent parameters announced by DEP in this regulation. The discharge may not contain more than 500 mg/L of TDS, no more than 250 mgL of total chlorides, and no more than 250 mgL of total sulfates as a monthly average. In addition I feel that discharge standards for other contaminants often found in Marcellus shale wastewater such as bromides, arsenic, radium, and others should be added to these regulations.

And I believe that drilling in Marcellus shale formations should cease until water treatment facilities have the ability to process frack water to with in the parameters of these proposed new regulations. Thank you.
