I am pleading with you to protect the streams and drinking water of Pennsylvania by strengthening, clarifying and enforcing Chapter 95 regulations. We need stronger standards to control what is dumped in our streams before any more drilling permits are issued. I urge you to include standards for all contaminants found in Marcellus waste water and to follow the standards of the federal government as well as the Delaware River Basin Commission.

All aspects of the Marcellus Shale frackwater must be monitored by strong TDS standards regulating the daily maximum not an average. Please don't change the proposed definition of large TDS standards. Make sure that all sources are covered.

As a lifelong resident of PA, a member of the Perry Co. Greenways Oversight Committee, the Susquehanna Appalachian Trail Club and a board member of the Keystone Trail Assoc. I ask you to protect the interests and welfare of our citizens, who you were appointed to serve, before the special interests of the corporations who are threatening our way of life and the safety of our woods and water.
