Dear Members:

I am writing in regard to Chap. 95. It should include the following:

Marcellus "frackwater" should be closely monitored for toxic elements.

Our streams should not be dumping grounds for frackwater.

The standard for Total Dissolved Solids should be stated as a daily minimum.

DEP should add discharge standards for bromides, arsenic, benzene, radium, magnesium and Volatile Organic Compounds.

We need these regulations to be in place as soon as possible.

Wastewater Reuse - DEP needs to ensure that all aspects of the generation of Marcellus wastewater are regulated.

There is little oversight at present over the reuse of Marcellus wastewater.
