As a life-long resident of Pennsylvania and as one particularly concerned with the quality of its environment, I would like to submit the following comments concerning the activities surrounding the exploration for gas supplies via Marcellus Shale deposits:

I would make these following points-

- frackwater must be monitored
- discharged water must meet standards for total dissolved solids; and these standards should be met based on a daily maximum basis
- the issuance of drilling permits should cease until chapter 95 revisions are in place

I believe these request and similar request should be implemented to avoid long term negative consequences for our potable water, from short term gains.
