INDEPENDENT REGULATORY REVIEW COMMISSION

Given the long past sordid history of mineral extraction in the Commonwealth, it is imperative that Pennsylvania now implement strong health-based standards for extraction of natural gas in the Marcellus Shale region. This will also prove essential for protection of other aspects of our environment.

Most states exact a fee for mineral extraction. Pennsylvania stands as a notable exception. These fees (or taxes) could be set aside in a trust fund to pay for ground water remediation and could also be used for strong regulatory controls and high inspection costs.
