I would like to support DEP's proposed changes to the Wastewater Treatment Requirements and the Chapter 95 standards it is trying to impose. Growing up in Southern California, a place which borrows its water from the Colorado River, I know all too well the importance of water in our lives, especially clean water. While that state is highly regulated, and in some cases, for good reason, I don't see similar regulations in place here, especially in light of the massive gas drilling that is sweeping our state.
