INDEPENDENT REGULATORY REVIEW COMMISSION

Dear Pennsylvania Environmental Quality Board,

- 1. Standardize on the base of health and human safety allowances for contaminants including arsenic, benzene, radium and magnesium that may be found in wastewater gas drilling.

- 4. Require drilling companies to track and report all of their pollution from drilling sites to treatment plants
- 5. Establish regulations to oversee the reuse of gas drilling wastewater. Everyone has a right to know about pollution being released into our environment or shipped into our communities.
- 6. Please make these points an immediate priority. It is already too late for so many. Pennsylvania is only so big and it is in your control. Please use your power to make the state you run worth as much as possible and not a wasteland.
