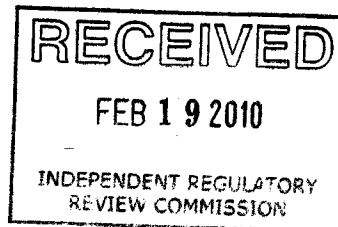

Dear Pennsylvania Environmental Quality Board,

As the Department of Environmental Protection considers new wastewater regulations, I urge you to include the following points:

Set health-based standards for contaminants including arsenic, benzene, radium and magnesium that may be found in wastewater gas drilling.

Approve and implement these standards as soon as possible in order to protect public health and our environment.

Require all sewage treatment plants to follow these proposed standards immediately.

It will be difficult, but if there is a way to have drilling companies to track and report all of their pollution from drilling sites to treatment plants, and establish regulations to oversee the reuse of gas drilling wastewater, it would be valuable to know the actual pollution.

The public has a right to know about pollution being released into our environment or shipped into our communities. It is important to safeguard our water supplies
