Regulation No. 6-319 (#2817) Department of Education Pennsylvania Pre-K Counts Requirements, Standards and Procedures

On January 27, 2010, the Independent Regulatory Review Commission (Commission) received this regulation from the Department of Education (Department). This rulemaking establishes 22 Pa. Code Chapter 405. Notice of proposed rulemaking was omitted for this regulation; it will become effective upon publication in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin*. On March 8, 2010, the Commission received a request from the Department to toll consideration of this final-omitted regulation to address statutory concerns, reliance on guidance documents and drafting errors. On April 7, 2010, the Department submitted its revisions to the final-omitted regulation to the Commission.

This final-omitted regulation establishes minimum standards for the operation of the Pre-K Counts Program

We have determined this regulation is consistent with the statutory authority of the Department (24 P.S. § 15-1513D(1)) and the intention of the General Assembly. Having considered all of the other criteria of the Regulatory Review Act, we find promulgation of this regulation is in the public interest.
