Environmental Quality Board Public 4 Hearing, Proposed Rulemaking, New Source of Review. 5 6 would like to welcome you to the Environmental Quality 7 Board's public hearing on the proposed regulations concerning Nonattainment New Source Review for PM2.5 8 9 Emissions. My name is Sachın Shankar. I am an 10 Environmental Engineer Manager with the Department of Environmental Protection's Southeast Regional Office. 11 I am representing the EQB at today's hearing. I 12 officially call this hearing to order at 1:08 p.m. 13 14 The purpose of this hearing is to 15 formally accept testimony on the proposed regulations concerning Nonattainment New Source Review for PM2.5 16 17 Emissions. In addition to this hearing, the EQB held a similar hearing yesterday in Pittsburgh and we'll 18 hold another hearing on Friday, March 12th, 2010 in 19 20 Harrisburg. 21 This Proposed Rulemaking, which was 22 adopted by the EQB on November 17, 2009 includes 23 amendments to existing Nonattainment New Source Review 24

requirements at 25 PA Code Chapters 121 and 127 in order to incorporate recently promulgated Federal

requirements for PM2.5 and PM2.5 precursors. amendments would limit the emissions of PM2.5 and PM2.5 precursors, including SO2 and NOx for new major air contamination sources or major air contamination sources being modified in certain counties and portions of counties of the Commonwealth that are designated as nonattainment of the PM2.5 National Ambient Air Quality Standard.

The following counties in Pennsylvania have been designated nonattainment for the 1997 PM2.5 annual NAAQS; Allegheny, Armstrong, Berks, Beaver, 12 Bucks, Butler, Cambria, Chester, Cumberland, Dauphin, Delaware, Greene, Indiana, Lancaster, Lawrence, Lebanon, Montgomery and Philadelphia counties. are approximately 700 major facilities in Pennsylvania that may be subject to the existing NSR rules if major modifications to those facilities are proposed.

The majority of these facilities affected by these regulatory changes are the already subject to the Commonwealth's existing NSR provisions in the Chapter 127. Therefore, it is not anticipated that significant additional costs would be incurred by the affected facilities to implement the provisions of this rulemaking. To provide increased flexibility to the owners and operators of sources in the

Commonwealth, the rulemaking includes PM2.5 precursor trading ratios to offset PM2.5 emissions increases in PM2.5 nonattainment areas.

The Department worked with the Air Quality Control Technical Advisory Committee, ACTAC in the development of this proposed rulemaking. AQTAC's May 28, 2009 meeting the committee concurred with the Department's recommendation to seek Board approval of the proposed rulemaking. In addition to consultation with AQTAC the Department presented the proposed rulemaking to the Citizens Advisory Council on July 21, 2009. 12

In order to give everyone an equal opportunity to comment on this proposal, I would like to establish the following ground rules. I will first call upon the witnesses who have pre-registered to testify at this hearing. After hearing from those witnesses, I will provide any other interested parties with the opportunity to testify as time allows.

Testimony is limited to ten minutes for Organizations are requested to each witness. designate one witness to present testimony on its Each witness is asked to submit three written behalf. copies of his or her testimony to aid in transcribing the hearing. Please hand me your copies prior to

presenting your testimony. Please state your name, address and affiliation for the record prior to presenting your testimony. The EQB would appreciate your help by spelling names and terms that may not be generally familiar so that the transcript can be as accurate as possible.

Because the purpose of a hearing is to receive comments on the proposal, EQB or DEP staff may question witnesses; however, the witnesses may not question the EQB or DEP staff. In addition to or in place of oral testimony presented at today's hearing, interested persons may also submit written comments on this proposal. All comments must be received by the EQB on or before April 12, 2010. Comments should be addressed to the Environmental Quality Board, P.O. Box 8477, Harrisburg, PA, 17105-8477. Comments may also be e-mailed to RegComments@state.pa.us.

All comments received at this hearing as well as written comments received by April 12, 2010 will be considered by the EQB and will be included in a Comment/Response document, which will be prepared by the Department and reviewed by the EQB prior to the Board taking its final action on this regulation.

Anyone interested in receiving a copy of the transcript of today's hearing may contact the EQB

for further information. I would like to call for the 1 first witness at this time. Since we do not have any witness we will go forward and complete the rest of 3 the hearing. Nobody has submitted any written 5 testimony for this hearing and no one is present at 6 this hearing as a witness.

I'm going to wait for 20 minutes for 8 witnesses who may be delayed due to traffic or other parking-related issues who may not be able to arrive 10 here on time. After 20 minutes, if no one is present 11 then I will adjourn the hearing. I'm going to wait 12 for 20 minutes.
