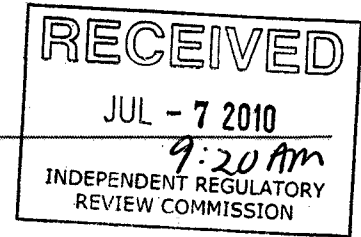

Subject: comment for the IRRRC (Independent Regulatory Review Commission) regarding proposed law 16A-7101

I think the proposed law is unfair, and honestly unconstitutional. Picking one agency over another of equal value is unethical.

I would propose the following:

Crane Operators must have a valid certification from a provider that

- provides NCCA or ANSI accredited certifications,
- is recognized by OSHA,
- tests on cranes relevant to the cranes the operator operates, and
- tests on OSHA regulations, ASME B30 Standards, and safe crane operations.

In addition, I would suggest that the final version of the law lists all NCCA or ANSI accredited providers simultaneously.
