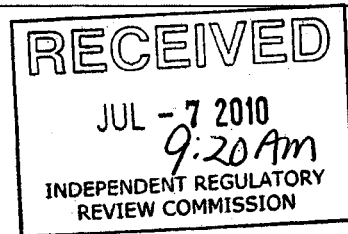

It was brought to my attention that you were in the process of implementing a crane certification program. I have extensive experience in the crane industry and currently hold a CIC operators card. Many of our clients are switching to CIC from the NCCO and being accepted throughout the country. Your bill proposed law 16A-7101 is an excellent concept and will make us all safer. The issue I have is it is written allowing only the NCCO to be accepted. Both NCCO and CIC are NCCA OSHA accredited and both determine that an operator is qualified. Allowing only NCCO to be accepted would create a monopoly and not allow operators for a cost effective alternative..
