5230.54 Supervision

Under the old regulations the option for how we performed supervision was a combined option of:

- b) Supervision must occur no less than twice per month, utilizing the following methods:
  - 1. Monitoring active PRS service delivery.
  - Individual case reviews.
  - 3. Staff meetings.
  - 4. Individual face-to-face staff supervisory sessions.

I believe the combination of all four options should be suffice for the no less than two times per calendar month supervision requirement.

Under the new regulations it seems to be more rigid in terms of individual supervison twice a month in addition to other methods. I do find value in group supervision and many times it leads to a much richer, more well rounded outcome to discussions and skills development.
