#### Transition to RUG-III Version 5.12 and Latest Assessment

## January 12, 2011

We submit for your consideration the following comments on the proposed rulemaking published in the November 13, 2010 *Pennsylvania Bulletin*. Our comments are based on criteria in Section 5.2 of the Regulatory Review Act (71 P.S. § 745.5b). Section 5.1(a) of the Regulatory Review Act (71 P.S. § 745.5a(a)) directs the Department of Public Welfare (Department) to respond to all comments received from us or any other source.

# 1. Section 1187.93. CMI calculations. – Implementation procedures; Clarity.

This regulation amends the Department's payment methodology to phase-in the use of a new classification system and the most recent resident assessments in determining the case-mix indices that are used in setting case-mix per-diem rates for non-public nursing facilities and in making certain incentive payments to county nursing facilities. In the proposed regulation, the Department applies rate settings to past rate years and quarters, in particular beginning with July 1, 2010. The Department needs to clarify how the new rates applied to these periods will occur retroactively. Similar concerns apply to Section 1187.96, Section1187.97, Appendix A, and Section 1189.105.
