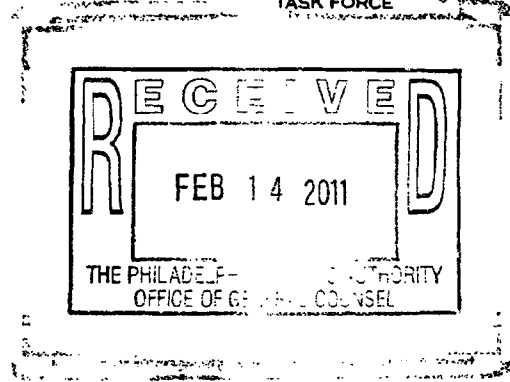

Dear Members of the Philadelphia Parking Authority:

Over the past few years the Marcellus Shale natural gas play has continued to be developed and has created many needed jobs for the Commonwealth, as well as hundreds of millions of dollars in state and local revenue. Natural gas as a vehicle fuel produces 90 percent less carbon dioxide emissions and 25 percent less carbon emissions than gasoline. Furthermore, it is roughly 75 cents cheaper per gallon equivalent than gasoline.

I respectfully request that the Philadelphia Parking Authority include natural gas vehicles as a taxicab option and be given the benefits proposed for hybrid and wheelchair accessible taxicabs.

Natural gas is clean, cheap and domestic. I thank you for your consideration.
