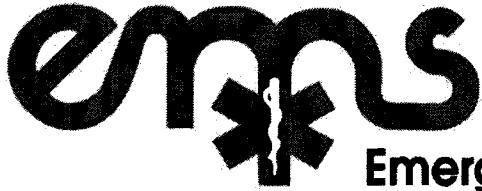


As President of Emergency Medical Services of Northeastern Pennsylvania, Inc., I am writing to support your approval of Regulation #10-190 which completes the Emergency Medical Services System Act 37.

Our organization serves as the Regional EMS Council for the northeastern part of the Commonwealth. The Board of Directors of our organization includes representation from pre-hospital providers, physicians, nurses, hospital administration, county EMA's, educators, businessmen, American Red Cross, and the general public.

Act 37, EMS Systems Act was a comprehensive revision to the previous act and allows for the EMS system to respond more quickly to evolving changes in the health care system.
