Michelle: We have reviewed PA Public Utility Commission final-form regulation #57-277 (IRRC #2950) and have concluded that it does not directly affect our members. In reviewing the proposed regulation we concluded that it is necessary for safety purposes and will benefit a community. Our only concern with the regulation is the authorization given to the utility to decide where an outside meter will be located. Since one's home is normally their biggest asset, it would be to the benefit of the homeowner and the community if the regulations would have provided location standards, or guidance documents for the utilities to follow. Without such documents, meters could be placed in awkward or inconvenient places without the homeowner or community having any recourse.
