Dear Mr. Chairman and Members of the Commission:

I am writing to voice my opposition to the proposed amendment regarding gas meter location. As a center city resident of a home in a historic district I am concerned about the consequences of your proposal.

My concerns are the proposed placement in regards to safety and aesthetics. Within the past year a car ran into and damaged 5 cars across my heavily traveled street. If there had been a meter there the results could have been devastating. Because my property is located in a center city neighborhood there is constant foot and shopping cart traffic on the sidewalk. Having a meter in front leaves a potential for damage, vandalism and creates a trip hazard. My last concern is the aesthetic impact on my property. A big grey gas meter will detract from the historic façade of the neighborhood and impact its value.
