Another aspect of the rules regarding MMA here in Pennsylvania I wish would be changed is the age limitation. I realize after reading the rules that it's not impossible for someone over the age of 36 to be awarded a license to fight MMA, but that the system in place currently makes it nearly impossible for someone over 36 years old to get licensed to fight when they otherwise might be qualified if not for their age.

I propose a system where a certified medical professional can certify a fighter (regardless of age) who wishes to fight that is capable of competing be allowed to fight in the cage. I feel this is something that many people would take advantage of if they only had the chance to compete & earn a living as a professional MMA fighter. I myself am over that age & would love to compete - but I feel the current system makes it almost impossible for me to get licensed... and I wish to have this corrected for me & others like me.
