Dear Chairman Mizner,

I am writing to you regarding the above regulation proposed by the PUC and my concerns on the impact this will have on the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and its residents.

Please review this potential regulatory change and its impact on the Certificated Household Goods Carriers.

The proposed final ruling addresses changes that the PUC deems necessary in order to increase competition, but not included in the rule are the comments of domicile on new applicants and increased fines for the unlicensed group that continues to be a major problem. We don't see where these Rogues will apply for authority, when they operate now without complying with the States rules and regulations governing this industry.

This places Pa. certificated movers at a competitive disadvantage with these groups.

So rather than the PUC being vigilant , please notify them that these need to be included in the final rule making order , so that all are on a level playing field.
