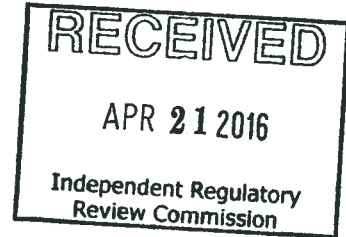

Clean water is indispensable, gas is an obsolete climate killer.

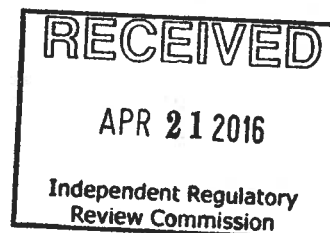
