On behalf of the Pennsylvania State Police (PSP), this correspondence is being submitted during the public comment period related to the Notice of Proposed Rulemaking, Document Number 18-460, relating to Mechanical, Electrical and Electronic Speed-Timing Devices.

We respectfully note that a technical correction is required within the body of Annex A. Specifically, the proposed new language of Section 105.34(b) makes reference to a requirement that certain documents be made available to the "State Police Inspection Station Supervisor." The position of Inspection Station Supervisor has not existed within the PSP for more than a decade; therefore, we suggest removal of that language. If this change were not made, it could be argued that there is no one within the PSP who would be entitled to request the subject documents. The corrected language we suggest would just refer to the "State Police," without any further specification of job function within the PSP.
