To the Department of Health Division of Immunization:

Hi my name is Janine Tokar. I am a mother of four from Grove City, Pennsylvania. I currently homeschool my 4th grader and 2nd grader. All my children are vaccinated according recommendations made by my pediatricians office (a UPMC provider). I am one of those Americans who is very grateful for the health benefits of vaccines.

Regarding changes to the school vaccination regulations (28 Pa. Code §§ 23.81–23.87), I humbly ask you to consider making one accommodation to the current proposal's reporting process. The current proposal requires home education programs to report immunization data to the Department of Health electronically. However, the proposal specifically gives public, private, parochial, or nonpublic schools **the ability to use a paper form** if they are unable to report electronically. It has come to my attention that <u>no such provision is included for home</u> <u>education programs</u>. *Could home education programs please be included in the list of education entities which may report on paper forms*?

I hope you will strongly consider my request. I am not the most technologically savvy and would be greatly relieved to have the paper option, not that I would rule out the electronic option. Thank you.
