I already had k registration for my school and if I knew this law was going to be enacted I would have handed out to the parents/guardians written notification.

Furthermore, many student register in the summer and a secretary would be responsible to notify these parents.

For example my school year 2015/2016 I had approx. 190 kindergarten students and probably at least 30 were not fully immunized. If I used the 5 day grace period rule, I would have to exclude those students and my administrator would have to support me in this matter.
