Dear Cynthia,

I applaud the changes in the immunization law. However, I think that 5 days is unrealistic. We nurses cannot possibly get through every student's immunization records and contact parents before school begins. We do not get extra days in the summer to work and the couple days before children start are spent on meetings, preparing our rooms and finding out about life-threatening allergies and illnesses. I think 30 days would be much more reasonable.

More importantly, I believe that getting rid of the moral, philosophical objection provisional would be much more beneficial. I have been getting many of those even with the 8 month provisional. Parents find out they can just sign a card and don't have to do anything else. That needs to be eliminated or at least made harder to do than just their signature. I fear many, many more of these with such a shortened time period with which to get needed immunizations.
