Greetings,

I am writing to you today to express concern about the changes proposed in IRRC #3147, which makes changes to title 28, chapter 23 of the Pennsylvania Code.

The proposed changes will not give parents enough flexibility in obtaining the required vaccines. Five days is far too short a time period creating a potential danger in requiring too many vaccine doses in a short period of time. A longer period of time, possibly closer to 60 days, may be needed to develop a plan for their children to safely receive the required vaccines.

When a child is infected by varicella (chickenpox), they may not necessarily be seen by a doctor. Since they have acquired their immunity naturally, a written statement from the parents should be sufficient evidence demonstrating a history of chickenpox.
