I am concerned about the proposed changes to title 28, chapter 23 of the Pennsylvania Code.

The current provisional 8-month period for students who need to be brought up to date on vaccines for admittance to school had been well thought-out when the law was created, and I am alarmed by the proposed replacement of a 5-day period. The increased risk to the student is not worth any perceived benefit. The 8 month period should stand as is.

As regards adding a doctor's certification of children receiving the varicella vaccine, there is no need for this increased requirement. A parents' written statement should continue to be treated as sufficient evidence demonstrating a history of chickenpox.
